PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

PLEASE NOTE: Our Parks and Recreation Facilities Are Tobacco-Free Areas.

- 1. Park hours are from Dawn to Dusk (lighted ball fields/courts until 11PM) at all parks.
- 2. Motorized vehicles & Parking the Speed Limit is 15 MPH in all parks. Parking is permitted only in the established parking lots. Parking is not permitted on the grass or in the pavilion areas.
- 3. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited. No person shall be under the influence of intoxicating alcohol or drugs.
- 4. All pets must be on a leash not more than six feet long. Owners must clean up all animal waste deposited by their pets.
- 5. No gambling is permitted.
- 6. Only charcoal is permitted in park grills. <u>GAS GRILLS ARE NOT PERMITTED</u> <u>WITHOUT WRITTEN PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE</u>. (Please contact the Parks & Recreation Office for further information.)
- 7. All refuse should be placed in the containers provided. Recycling is required at our parks.
- 8. Any defacement, removal, or damage of any park property will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- 9. Gathering or removing any wood, turf, soil or other materials at <u>any</u> park is prohibited, unless specifically permitted in writing by the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation.
- 10. Profane language is prohibited.
- 11.No concessions, other than those operated within municipally-owned concession stands and approved by the Township Manager, shall operate on Township property.

- 12. Liability insurance for certain events or activities may be required by the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation.
- 13. No person may hunt, trap or pursue wildlife in any park at any time.
- 14.**A permit will be issued to the applicant once it has been reviewed and approved by the Recreation Director. Applicant <u>must have this permit</u> with them on the day of the event. Permits are mailed to the applicant, time permitting. If reservation is made less than 5 days prior to the event, applicant must pick up permit at the Recreation Office in order to insure receipt and reservation has been completed.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

If any additional equipment or livestock (stereos, gas grills, tents, or bounce houses, pony rides etc.) are to be brought onto park property during your event(s), the Parks and Recreation Department must be notified in writing 2 weeks prior to the event.
