The Goals of the STPR CIT (Counselor-in-Training) Program

- Develop enthusiastic, motivational, and responsible leaders
- Increase interaction between teens, children, and adults to create meaningful relationships
- Introduce teens to future employment opportunities
- Provide positive role models for teens and children
- Promote teamwork
- Maintain a high level of recreational opportunities to STPR participants



*The goal of our CIT program is to prepare our volunteers for successful employment either with us or a similar position. Becoming a CIT does <u>not</u> automatically secure a position with STPR, but is a good stepping stone for employment. Solid performance and good evaluations will be valuable in helping secure a position with STPR when the applicant is old enough to apply for a paid position.

Counselor -in- Training Qualifications

Qualifications:

- Must have completed the 8th grade
- Should be available for at least 2 weeks of the 7 week program
- Should have some experience working with children
- Leadership skills
- Enthusiasm and motivation
- Be willing to assist in whatever capacity is needed by the paid staff.



Responsibilities & Daily Expectations

Responsibilities

- Assist with staff at Day Camp or Playground site
- Assist on field trips by helping with attendance and organization
- Take on leadership roles (i.e. leading a game, teaching a sport or talent) as situations arise
- Pay for all field trips if the site does not compensate for staff

Daily Expectations:

- Be punctual
- Come with enthusiasm!
- Advise staff ahead of absenteeism
- Wear staff ID tag
- Wear staff shirt to all field trips
- Wear tshirt/shorts/sneakers ready for active play
- Represent the Department in all matters while on site.

Steps to Apply:

- Complete and submit CIT application
- Obtain references from at least 2 individuals
- Schedule and participate in an interview with STPR staff
- Obtain appropriate clearances or provide information to the Department in order to secure clearances.
- Fill out any additional paperwork in a timely manner

Applications will be accepted <u>no later than March 31, 2020</u> Eligible applicants will be contacted for an interview. Interviews for new CIT applicants will take place in April.
