## SUSQUEHANNA TOWNSHIP PARKS

<u>Veterans Memorial Park</u> – Ward 7 (25 acres) Located at 1955 Elmerton Avenue across from the State Police Building. Sitting between the Game Commission and Fish & Boat Commission properties, amenities include: a lighted baseball field, lighted softball field, 4.5 acre soccer complex, and playground with swings, slide and climbing gym, a pavilion with 9 picnic tables, restrooms, kitchen, refrigerator/freezer, microwave and electrical outlets. Shuffle-board court, sand volleyball court, basketball court and lighted tennis courts.

The Memorial Plaza has monuments honoring Word War II and Korean Veterans in place with future memorials to include Viet Nam and Desert Storm Veterans.

<u>Edgemont Community Park</u> – Ward 3 (11 acres) Located at the intersection of Locust Lane and Edgemont Road, adjacent to the Salvation Army Building. Amenities include: a play structure for ages 5 -12, swings, pavilion with 6 tables, restrooms, and softball field.

<u>Christian McNaughton Memorial Park</u> – ward 2 (7.5 acres) behind Thomas Holtzman, Jr. Elementary School. Amenities include: a pavilion with 2 picnic tables, preschool play structure for 2 – 5 year olds, swings, baseball field, soccer field, and concession stand with restrooms.

<u>Crown Point Park</u> – Ward 3 (4.25 acres) 2445 Walker Mill Road, at the intersection of Aspen Way. Newly developed Neighborhood park amenities include benches, pavilion, 4 picnic tables, rest rooms, grill, walking path, game court, playground with a play structures for 5-12 year olds and a play structure for 2 -5 year olds.

<u>Donald B. Stabler Memorial Park</u> – Ward 1 (7.85 acres) Located Just off of 6<sup>th</sup> Street (Linglestown Road) at 4331 Kaby Street. Amenities include a play structure for ages 5 - 12, a play structure for ages 2- 5, softball field, basketball court, restrooms, baseball field and concession stand.

<u>Plum Alley Park</u> – Ward 6 (.8acre) Located off 39<sup>th</sup> Street, one block north of Rauch Street. Play structure for ages 5 - 12, swings, and a pavilion with 2 picnic tables.

<u>Shutt Mill Park</u> – Ward 9 (5 acres) Located off of Crooked Hill Road. Entrance is just north of Shutt Mill Road. Amenities include a pavilion with 2 picnic tables and basketball court. The Township has received an additional 5 acres.

<u>Olympus Heights</u> – Ward 9 (1.5 acres) Off of Crooked Hill Road on Apollo Avenue. Amenities include a basketball court and entrance way into Dauphin County's Wildwood Park.

<u>Beaufort Hunt Playground</u> – Ward 8 (2.8 acres) Located in Beaufort Farms Development, Mount Vernon Circle. Amenities include a play structure with swings, slide and a pavilion with 2 picnic tables.

<u>Logan Farm Park</u> – Ward 3 (52 acres) Adjacent to Crown Point Park off of Walker Mill Road and Aspen Way. This park will be a scenic natural setting with trails.

Future park locations:

<u>Apple Creek Farms Development</u> - Ward 9 (2.68 acres) At Pebble Drive and Jonagold Drive. No recreation equipment, currently open green space.

<u>Margaret's Grove Development</u> - Ward 2 (6 acres) Continental Avenue. Dedicated to the Township on October 1, 2015. Open green space for future recreation development.

<u>Waverly Woods Development -</u> Ward 2 (19.84 acres) North of Linglestown Road at Continental Avenue and Progress Avenue. Wooded acreage with a pond. Dedicated to the Township on April 2011.
