Committee Reports

Recreation Director's Report

Veterans Memorial Park Project

Director Reichard reported that the project is moving along, subject to weather conditions. Some "work" parts of the project are underway. Completion of the project is estimated for the middle of June. The idea of doing a "grand opening" celebration was discussed.

Boyd Park Project, Waverly Woods Development

Grant funds were received. Prior to work, HRG is assisting the Township with project restrictions. **Director Reichard** is gathering designs and will be looking for approval of a sign for the Boyd Park Project.

Edgemont Park Basketball Court Renovations

The Chris Franklin Foundation is working on a project to renovate/update the current Edgemont Community Park basketball court. The project is slated to begin on or after June 2018. The Township Public Works Department will provide assistance if and when practical/permissible. Chris Krawczuk made a motion to support the project. Arlene Prentice seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously approved.

Old Business

Susquehanna Township Athletic Association (STAA)

Chair Tony Wright reviewed the purpose of the STAA. Items of interest were the development of a 501(c)3 Nonprofit Organization, participation by current township sport associations, and asking each association what they are interested in seeing as the role of STAA. Tony reviewed the proposed mission statement and by-laws
