3. AUTHORIZATION TO ADVERTISE A PUBLIC HEARING ON AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PROPERTY OWNER OF 2000

LINGLESTOWN ROAD (TAX PARCEL 62-013-006) TO INSTALL A SIDEWALK ON CROOKED HILL ROAD

Narrative

The Public Works Committee discussed a concern that was raised about a missing segment of sidewalk on the eastern side of Crooked Hill Road adjacent to an office complex owned by 2000 Associated, LLC of Chambers Hill Road. The missing segment would connect the existing sidewalk on Linglestown Road with another existing segment north of the intersection. The missing segment measures approximately 280 lineal feet. Pursuant to the First Class Township Code, the Board may, by ordinance, direct the adjacent property owner to install the sidewalk upon serving notice with at least 60 days to comply. The missing segment is a hazard especially during snow and icy conditions. Staff is recommending the Board schedule a public hearing on an ordinance to direct the installation of the notice. The property owner has been notified of this matter, as well.

Recommended motion: That the Board of Commissioners authorize advertisement of a public hearing on an ordinance directing the property owner of 2000 Linglestown Road to install sidewalk on Crooked Hill Road for Thursday, June 13, 2024.
