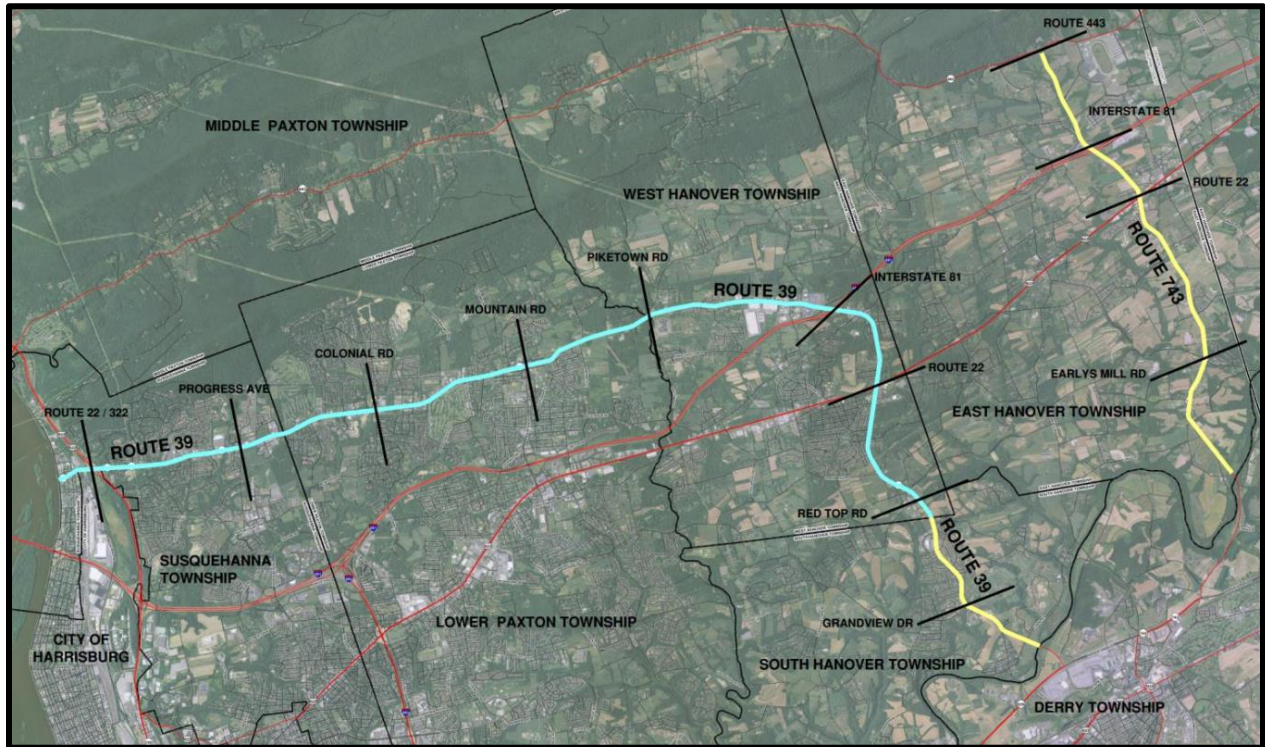


Route 39 and 743 Corridor Transportation and Land Use Study Public Meeting
