REPORTS OF AUTHORITY STAFF

Manager

Written report submitted for the month of April 2021. Ms. Lovett presented an invoice for a Joint Pollution Reduction Plan project for Stonebridge. This project is hosted by Lower Paxton Township and the participants are Lower Paxton, Susquehanna Township and Capital Region Water. Susquehanna Township's percentage is 27% of the total cost of the project which is a stream restoration. The Authority's portion is in the amount of \$222,345.00. Mr. Pollart motioned to approve the payment for \$222,345.00 to Lower Paxton Township; Mr. Lynch seconded. It was approved unanimously.

Ms. Lovett reported there was a shut off list for the month of May included in the packet. These would be tagged during the month.

Mr. Laskowski updated the Board on the Capital Region Water Shut Off Agreement. Mr. Laskowski received the requested language changes on the contract from CRW and is recommending acceptance and approval of the contract. Mr. Sanderson motioned to accept and approve the Capital Region Water Shut Off Agreement; Mr. Napper seconded. It was approved unanimously.

Corrective Action Plans – Mr. Kostelac reported to the Board a summary of the pump station upgrades that was discussed at the Construction and Planning Meeting from April 27, 2021. Mr. Kostelac discussed the process of the automatic dialers and the need for the equipment as a part of the total upgrade to the pump stations. Mr. Kostelac is recommending the approval of the proposal from Envirep TLC in the amount of \$38,860.00 for 7 automatic dialers and installation of them. Mr. Pollart motioned to approve the payment to Envirep TLC in the amount of \$38,860.00. Mr. Napper Seconded and the Motion was approved unanimously.

<u>Extension</u> – Mr. Kostelac updated the Board on the progress of the Southeast Sanitary Sewer Extension Project. With limited construction activities, work can now continue with the minor permit amendment that addresses the wetland encroachment and onsite fill activities. If compliance by RIII continues, the timeline is on track for late 2021 completion. Mr. Kostelac requested the Board consider payment to RIII, contractor of

the SE Extension Project, of Application for Payment #6 in the amount of \$142,548.30 and it is recommended for payment. Mr. Sanderson motioned to approve the payment to RIII for the Application for Payment 6 in the amount of \$142,548.30. Mr. Napper Seconded and the Motion was approved with a 2 to 1 vote with the Chair abstaining.
