SUSQUEHANNA TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF THE SUSQUEHANNA TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY,
DAUPHIN COUNTY, PA REDUCING THE AMOUNT PAID TO THE CITY OF
HARRISBURG FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Susquehanna Township Authority and various suburban communities, to include Lower Paxton Township Authority, Swatara Township Authority, Borough of Paxtang, Borough of Pennbrook, and Borough of Steelton (the “Suburban Communities”) have had in effect since approximately September 15, 1976, an agreement with the City of Harrisburg and the Harrisburg Sewage Authority (collectively the “City”) relative to the conveyance, treatment and discharge from wastewater flows emanating from Susquehanna Township Authority and the other Suburban Communities; and

WHEREAS, certain concerns have arisen relative to the proper rates being charged by the City for such services and Susquehanna Township Authority and the various other Suburban Communities have engaged special legal counsel and rate consultants relative to a review of the charges levied by the City for sanitary sewage transmitted by the Suburban Communities to Harrisburg’s Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, Susquehanna Township Authority and the other Suburban Communities have been advised by special legal counsel that it is appropriate and he therefore recommends a reduction of the sanitary sewer rate paid to the City of Harrisburg for sanitary sewage transmitted by the Suburban Communities into the City in large part based upon the sewer rate review report of AUS Consultants of October 23, 2012.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of the Susquehanna Township Authority that based upon the advice of special legal counsel, as supported by the AUS Consultants report of October 23, 2012, the Susquehanna Township Authority shall reduce the sanitary sewer rate paid to the City of Harrisburg for sanitary sewage treated at its base Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that effective with the next invoice received by Susquehanna Township Authority by the City of Harrisburg for sanitary sewer services, Susquehanna Township Authority shall provide payment at the rate of \$30.37 per quarter, per residential structure (Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU)) and \$1.869 per 1,000 gallons for non-residential flows.

ADOPTED this 4 day of December 2012 by the Board of the Susquehanna Township Authority.
